be a sister to every Girl Scout.*

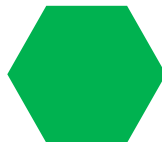

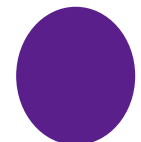



## Making the first year as a leader a total success!



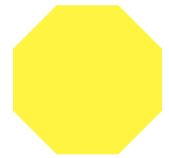
### 1st year Daisy Troops

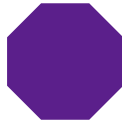


# Annual Meeting
