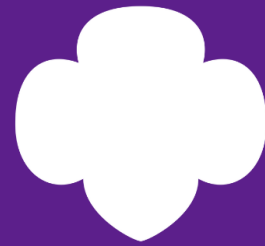
plight of rehabilitated elephants.

Together with these partners, our Girl Scouts set out to achieve significant goals in record time. As valued supporters, we're excited to share the highlights with you.

Here's the scoop: our Girl Scouts created over 100 Science Journals for the Natural History Museum of Utah's Women in Science and Technology event, planted 50 trees in collaboration with the Jordan River Commission, assembled 167 toiletry kits for the YCC Domestic Violence Shelter and Lantern House Shelter, crafted 50 vests for unhoused individuals to keep them warm, and put together 130 hygiene kits and 30 Easter baskets for children. The impact was truly extraordinary!
